

Anticipated Work—Week of January 17, 2022

National Water Main will begin CIPP installation on the following streets:

- Tuesday, January 18th, 2022 – Purvis Street (between Charles Street and Main Street); Lexington Street (between Main Street and Acton Street)
- Wednesday, January 19th, 2022 – Puritan Road; Falmouth Road; Pilgrim Road (between Puritan Road and Acton Street)
- Thursday, January 20th, 2022 – Lexington Street (between Bemis Street and Main Street); Howard Street (between Main Street and Pleasant Street)
- Friday, January 21st, 2022 – Main Street (between Edenfield Avenue and Bacon Street); Brandley Road

Note: If your home or business is connected to the sewer line being rehabilitated, your sewer service will be temporarily blocked off from the sewer mainline once the liner is inflated.

During this time your water service is not shut off and you can continue using it for drinking, cooking and other purposes, but residents are asked to limit water use. You should avoid taking showers or baths, running your dishwasher and washing machine, and also be sure to turn off all sump pumps connected to your sewer service. Flush your toilets sparingly. Using small amounts of water to wash your hands or brush your teeth is okay. See web-site for additional information.

- Continue gas main replacement on Winter Street
- Continue gas main replacement on Pine Street and Nash Street
