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Construction Updates
Week of May 16, 2022

Note: All work is weather-dependent and subject to change.

City-wide Catch Basin Cleaning (BMC Corporation)

- Contractor will begin cleaning catch basins throughout the City. Limited parking restrictions may be posted to allow access to catch basins.

Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitations Contract 21-01S (National Water Main)

- National Water Main will continue to perform CIPP installation on the following streets:
 - Nyack Street (Between Tappan Ave and Belmont Street)
 - Orchard Street (Between Lexington Street and Whitney Street)
- National Water Main will continue to grout service connections and seal manholes on various streets in the [project area](#).

Substandard Water Service and Lead Gooseneck Replacement Program (AD Paolini LLC)

- Crews will continue water service replacements at #55 Olney Street, #223-#225 Watertown Street, #79-#91 Melendy Avenue and #43-#45 Hall Avenue.
- Crews will continue permanent restoration of trenches, sidewalk panels, and planting strips at water service replacement locations performed last year.

2022 Road Program (Lorusso Corporation)

- Crews will pulverize, fine grade, and binder pave Locke Street and Chester Street

Sidewalk Repairs (Century Paving)

- Continue accessible ramp installation on Pierce Road, Grant Street and Duff Street.
- Begin sidewalk repairs on Sycamore Street.

Sidewalk Repairs (Antonellis Construction)

- Continue sidewalk repairs on Stoneleigh Road and Stoneleigh Circle.

Ridgelawn Cemetery Water Main (AD Paolini LLC)

- Contractor will test and chlorinate the new water main and begin service transfers pending testing results.

Cottage Street Neighborhood Drainage Improvements (Commonwealth Construction)

- Begin drainage work on Sawin Street, pending material delivery.
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Other Utilities

National Grid Gas

- Crews will continue gas main installation on Mount Auburn Street at various locations.
 - Crews will continue installing access pits on Boyd Street to support gas main lining.
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
