**SUBSTANDARD AND LEAD GOOSENECK
WATER SERVICE REPLACEMENTS**

#38 Sparkill Street; #23 James Street; #5, #9, #25 and #51-53 Harrington Street; #31 and #38 Nyack Street; #50 Townly Road; #112 Brookline Street; #41 Morrison Road; and #15 and #24 Charles Street

Dear Residents and Abutters:

The Watertown Department of Public Works and our contractor Paolini LLC would like to inform you that we will be replacing sub-standard (cement lined and/or cast iron with lead goosenecks) water services at the addresses listed above.

Replacements and upgrades will include only the water service pipe from the City water main to the curb stop (usually in the sidewalk area). The work for each home will require approximately 3-6 hours to complete and during that period you will not have water service. The contractor will reach out to you prior to shutting off water. If you wish to make an appointment, please call Paolini LLC directly at 617-454-4277.

Once the work has been performed, your water service will be restored. This work may cause discoloration of your water when reinstated, if so, run your cold water only in the lowest faucet in your home and it will clear itself within five minutes typically.

Weather permitting, work will begin on Tuesday, June 28, 2022.

The Watertown Police will be informed of the construction and its effects. Typical hours of construction work are from 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
